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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- SIU SOM's first year (Y1) of medical school is comprised of three units: Cardio/Respiratory/Renal (CRR), Neural/Muscular/Behavioral (NMB), and Endocrine/Reproduction/Gastro (ERG).
- There were 76 total students in the Y1 cohort in AY 2019/2020
- Y1 asked students to evaluate each unit as a whole.
- Things we learned:
 - The tool used to evaluate units in AY 2019/2020 changed in AY 2020/2019. The tool for 2019/2020 does not lend itself to quick quantitative analysis beyond counts. The newer tool is positive growth.
 - Our units and our learning experiences within units are, on average, rated favorably by students.
 - We need to explore ways for increasing our response rates. Analysis of AY 2020/2019 summaries indicate response rates have increased, likely due to a more streamlined evaluation tool.
